

Requirements to complete 977 Career Pathway: Carpentry endorsement:

Responsibilities:

- The position requires demonstration of disciplinary skills, excellent classroom management skills, maintaining classroom/shop equipment/supplies, and normal classroom/career and technical education record keeping and reporting.
- Prepare and teach Construction Technology/Carpentry
- Maintain regular and Career and Technical educational record keeping
- Complying with reports to MDE and other agencies in a timely manner
- Ability to supervise high school students in a classroom setting, student organization activities and competitions
- Must possess or be willing to acquire bus driving certification
- Other duties as assigned

Required Qualifications:

- Education as stated above.
- Technology literacy and related assessment of that competency - IC3 or Propulse
- Occupational experience and related assessment of that experience - National Center for Construction Education and Research (NCCER), National Craft Assessment and Certification Program: Earn required score on Commercial Carpentry assessment. OR Hold a currently valid Residential Builder's License, based on results of required examination, and issued from MS State Board of Contractors. OR Other teacher occupational competency assessment approved by MDE Office of Career and Technical Education.
- Applicant must enroll and complete the individualized professional development plan requirements of the Vocational Instructor Preparation (VIP) or the College and Career Readiness Educator Program (CCREP) prior to the expiration date of the three-year vocational license.
- Applicant must successfully complete the Contren Instructor Certification.
- Applicant must successfully complete a Certification for online learning workshop.
- Applicant must successfully complete the Construction Technology Certification workshop.
 - Note: If the applicant meets all requirements listed above, that applicant will be issued a 977 endorsement - a five year license. If the applicant does not meet all requirements, the applicant may be issued a three-year endorsement (license), and all requirements stated above must be satisfied prior to the ending date of that license.
