On motion by Hayden Kirkhart to approve the updated 2025 Spring semester budget and seconded by Cielee Hollon. All members present and participating voted unanimously to approve the new Spring 2025 budget.

After discussion the Cabinet decided not to approve spending for a mechanical bull, but for food and drinks. On motion by Hayden Kirkhart to approve spending \$500 for food and drinks for the bonfire and seconded by Aubrey Claire Norris. All members present and participating voted unanimously to approve spending \$500 for the bonfire.
