

Delta State University Interfraternity Council General Council Minutes Monday, October 5, 2015

A call to order was made at 5:07 P.M. by IFC President Cunningham.

All IFC members were present with the exception of George Bond, Chace Holland, Mitch McCormick and Austin Goff.

A motion to approve minutes was made by Myers; second by Hartz.

No officer reports were made.

Kappa Alpha reported that a change in their chapter's IFC Alternate Voting Delegate will need to be made by next meeting. The selection and approval will occur during the next meeting. Kappa Sigma had no report. Phi Mu Alpha had no report. Pi Kappa Alpha fundraised over \$5,000 during their philanthropy events on Fireman's Week. Sigma Alpha Epsilon had no report.
